STATEMENT CONCERNING THE PROPOSED BYLAWS AND THE CONDUCT

BUSINESS

- 1(a) Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 7179, 2007** [a bylaw to establish the Albert Crescent Comprehensive Development Districts (RM-CD-4)]
- 1(b) Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 7180, 2007** [a bylaw to rezone the properties addressed as 126, 128 and 130 Agnes Street, 127 and 131 Dickenson Street, a portion of Dickenson Street, all of Sarnia Street and all of Albert Crescent]
- 1(c) Development Permit 002 (AC) with variances**

The property addressed as 132 Agnes Street would not be part of the development, and would be considered a “locked in lot”. In (R) Districts, it is unlawful to construct any building, or portion of a building, that would result in the creation of a locked in lot. Therefore, a variance is required in to permit creation of a locked in lot at 132 Agnes Street in order to construct the proposed apartment building. The locked in lot would have a frontage of 33 feet and an area of 2178 square feet.
