Duties:

- do a weather check at 9am to determine if weather permits the show to go on – shows are weather permitting
- update the New Westminster Parks, Culture and Recreation hotline with show details
- show up at Queens Park bandshell, as schedule dictates
- greet the entertainment for the day
- help with any setups they need; you will have access to bandshell store room if supplies are needed (ie. Chairs)
- introduce the act at the start of the show
- enjoy the show
- thank act at the end of their show
- clean up as needed
