How can you recycle better?
Start with the list below. Encourage others.

- Corrugated cardboard
- Newsprint
- Office/Mixed paper
- Beverage containers (all except milk & milk products)
- Blue box recyclables
- Medications/pharmaceuticals
- Yard and garden waste
- Gypsum drywall
- Lead-acid (car batteries)
- Paint, solvents, flammable liquids, gasoline and pesticides
- Vehicle tires
- Oil, oil filters and empty containers
- Electronic waste, such as computers & other computer components
- Printers & TVs

These recyclable and hazardous waste materials have not been allowed in the garbage since January 1, 2008.
