BYLAW NO. 5745, 1988

A Bylaw to require the approval of the City before the cutting of trees

WHEREAS S. 978 of the Municipal Act empowers the City of New Westminster to regulate or prohibit the cutting of trees in areas that it considers may be subject to flooding, erosion, land slip or avalanche;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of New Westminster considers that certain areas of land may be subject to such hazards;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL of the Corporation of the City of New Westminster in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Tree Cutting Bylaw No. 5745, 1988.
2. Those parcels of land, outlined in heavy black lines on Schedule "A", are hereby designated as areas in which no trees may be cut without a valid permit.

Bylaw No. 6045, 1992

"land within thirty (30) metres of the high water mark of the Brunette River, including the Brunette River Flood Diversion Works, all as shown on the Schedule attached hereto."

3. Every applicant for said permit shall submit, at his expense, a report certified by a qualified person, agreed upon by the applicant and the City, that the proposed cutting of trees will not create a danger from flooding, erosion or land slip.

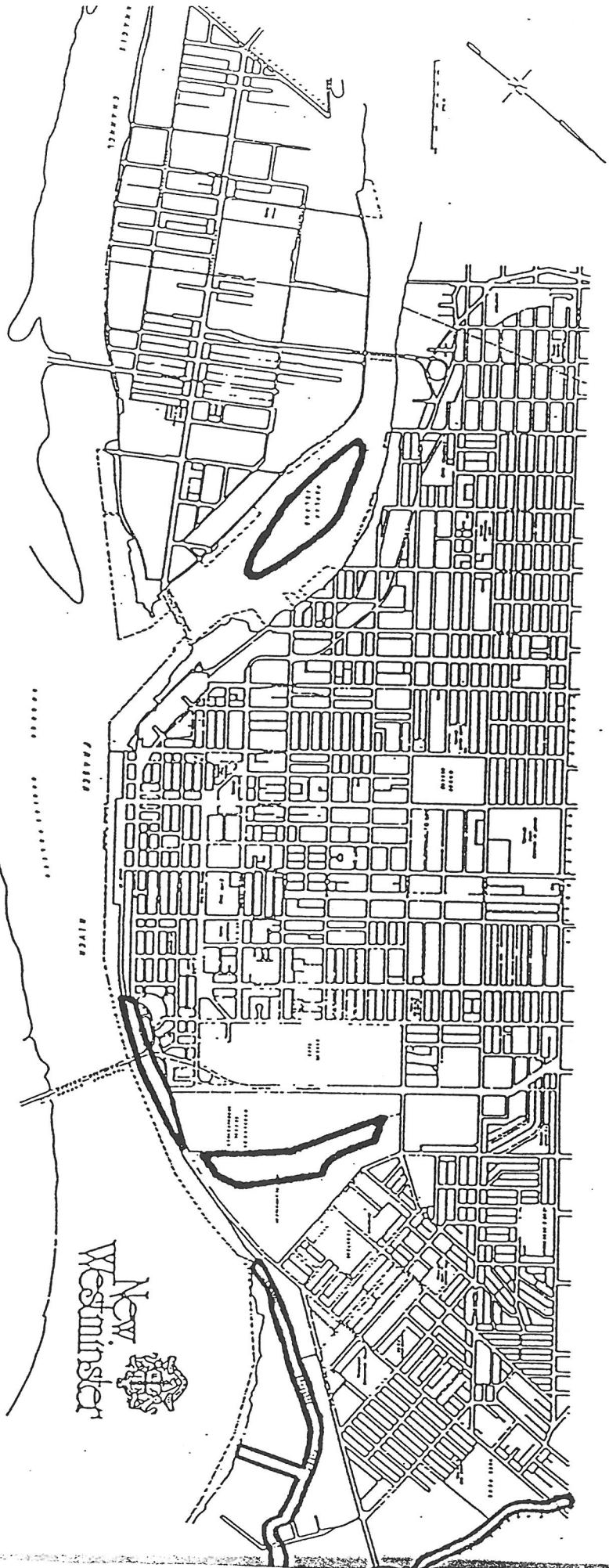
