RECOMMENDATION

THAT Street Traffic Amendment Bylaw No. 7171, 2007 be given three readings.

ORIGIN/PURPOSE

To update the map of the truck routes shown in Schedule 5.1 of the bylaw.

ANALYSIS

There have been many changes to the truck routes over the years. Schedule 5 of the bylaw, which is a list of designated truck routes, has been updated whenever a change has been made. The map of the truck routes, Schedule 5.1, has remained unchanged and is not consistent with the list.

INTERDEPARTMENTAL LIAISON

This inconsistency in the bylaw was brought to our attention by Parking Control Services. Parking Control officers were unable to adequately enforce truck route violations due to the discrepancy.

CONCLUSION

The truck route map has been updated to reflect the current designated truck routes.
