

Walking Tour QUEEN'S PARK

This 3.3 km walk starts at the historic Queen's Park Arena, meanders through the adjacent forest and the surrounding neighbourhoods passing through Glenbrook Ravine and returning to Queen's Park.

While in the Queen's Park forest, take note of its impressive fauna as this area is home to some of the oldest trees in New Westminster. The lush canopy provides reprieve from the sun and rain, making it a great spot for family adventures.

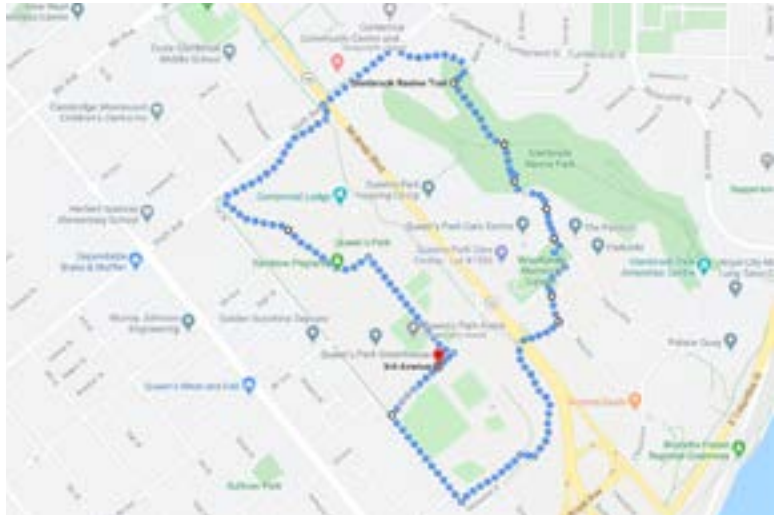

Here are printable directions to take along with you:

1. Start in front of the arena in Queen's Park
2. Head Southwest on Third Avenue toward Millennium Trail 160m
3. Turn left onto Millennium Trail 250m
4. Turn left 180m
5. Turn right toward Millennium Trail 290m
6. Turn Right toward Ross Drive 110m
7. Turn left onto Ross Drive 92m
8. Turn left toward Blackberry Drive 85m
9. Turn right toward Blackberry Drive 12m
10. Turn left onto Blackberry Drive 140m
11. Slight right onto Glenbrook Ravine Trail 190m
12. Head northeast on Glenbrook Ravine Trail toward Glenbrook Drive 48m
13. Turn Left onto Glenbrook Drive 190m
14. Turn left onto Sixth Avenue/E Sixth Avenue 210m
15. Turn left toward Millennium Trail 36m
16. Turn right onto Millennium Trail 300m
17. Turn left 400m
18. Turn right 300m
19. Turn right onto Third Avenue 46m
20. Welcome back to the starting point
