BYLAW NO. 6226, 1994

A Bylaw Respecting Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy

WHEREAS, the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, S.B.C. c. 61 will be applicable to local government.

AND WHEREAS Section 76.1 the said Act authorizes a local public body by bylaw to appoint a head for purposes of information requests, and, also, to impose fees for the dissemination of information.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL of the Corporation of the City of New Westminister in open meeting assembled ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 6226, 1994.

BYLAW 7605, 2013

2. The Chief Administrative Officer is designated as the Head for the purposes of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and in collaboration with the Director of Finance and the Director of Legislative Services shall form the FOI Committee.

BYLAW 7605, 2013

3. Applications for information or correction of personal information shall be on forms attached as Schedule 'A' to this bylaw and shall be submitted to the FOI Committee for review.

BYLAW 7628, 2013

4. ***Schedule "B" (fees for services rendered in providing information) is deleted. Fees will be incorporated in Fees Bylaw No. 6186, 1994.***

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon proclamation of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, S.B.C. 1993, c. 46 and from the date of its registration with the Inspector of Municipalities.
