BYLAW NO. 6482, 1998

A Bylaw to Provide for the Issuance of
Tickets for Enforcement of City Bylaws

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act* R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323 empowers Council, by bylaw, to:

- (a) designate those bylaws which may be enforced by means of a form of ticket prescribed by regulation;
- (b) designate bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of enforcing bylaws by means of a prescribed form of ticket;
- (c) designate an offence against a bylaw by means of a word or expression on a ticket; and
- (d) in consultation with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court set fines, not exceeding \$500.00 for contravention of the designated bylaws.

THE CITY COUNCIL of the Corporation of the City of New Westminster in open meeting assembled HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw No. 6482, 1998".
2. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for that purpose by the *Municipal Act*.
3. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Bylaw are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 opposite the respective job positions or titles.

BYLAW NO. 6912, 2004'

4. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules 2 through 21 to this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.

5. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules 2 through 21 to this Bylaw are the fines set pursuant to the *Community Charter* of the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
6. This Bylaw takes effect upon the date of its adoption.
