### **Information Regarding Construction Noise Bylaw No. 6063, 1992**

- Construction noise is permitted between 7:00 am and 8:00 pm Monday to Friday **and** between 9:00 am and 6:00 pm Saturdays.
- Construction noise is **NOT** permitted:
  - before 7:00 am or after 8:00 pm Monday to Friday;
  - before 9:00 am or after 6:00 pm Saturdays;
  - on Sundays and the following **2024** statutory holidays: January 1 (New Year's Day), February 19 (Family Day), March 29 (Good Friday), May 20 (Victoria Day), July 1 (Canada Day), August 5 (BC Day), September 2 (Labour Day), September 30 (National Day for Truth and Reconciliation), October 14 (Thanksgiving Day), November 11 (Remembrance Day), and December 25 (Christmas Day).
- All reasonable steps to minimize noise from construction sites must be implemented including but not limited to ensuring mufflers are in good repair, avoiding unnecessary idling, revving, use of airbrakes and banging of tail gates, and turning off equipment when not in use.
- A resident may carry out construction on his or her residence on Sundays or other holiday between 9:00 am and 6:00 pm, provided the construction is not being carried out for profit or gain.
- Construction work that does not create noise is permitted at any time by anyone.
- If it is impractical or impossible to carry out the construction during permitted hours, Mayor and Council may by resolution, extend the permitted hours. Be advised all required information must be received a minimum of three weeks prior to the commencement of the work in order for an extension to be considered.
