**Defining Lawn Watering Methods**

Automatic	Manual
<p>Automatic watering means applying water using an automated water delivery system that requires only minimal human intervention or supervision and typically employs mechanical, electronic, or other components and devices, including but not limited to timers, sensors, computers, or mechanical appliances.</p>	<p>Manual watering means applying water using a device or tool that is manually held or operated by a human, without automatic watering.</p>
Examples of automatic methods	Examples of manual methods
<p>Mechanical device - Water Timer</p> 	<p>Watering Can</p> 
<p>Automatic Irrigation System</p> 	<p>High Pressure Air Pump Manual Sprayer</p> 
<p>Automatic sprinkler with automatic shut off valves</p> 	<p>Manual Watering Bottle</p> 
<p>Manual hose with automatic shut off device</p> 	<p>Self-watering ideas that are not automated.</p>
