<p>The proposal is to build a new aquatic and community centre facility with a gross floor area of 10, 618sqm (114, 291sf) with a floor space ratio (FSR) of 0.21. The new facility is intended to replace the City's existing Canada Games Pool and Centennial Community Centre. The New Westminster Aquatic and Community Centre (NWACC) will be constructed between the existing facilities and the east-west Metro Vancouver right-of-way on the site between McBride Boulevard, Sixth Avenue, Cumberland Street and the Justice Institute. The working title identified for temporary use (i.e. during the planning phase) for this facility is "New Westminster Aquatic and Community Centre" (NWACC).</p>
