



New Westminster Community Grants Glossary

1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1. *City* – the Corporation of the City of New Westminster
- 1.2. *Community Groups* – organizations that are not incorporated but operate solely for the benefit of the community, rather than for their own members.
- 1.3. *Community Partners* – All community organizations are the City's partners in achieving the City's vision and the City supports these partners to have impact. Community partners include:
 - Community Groups
 - Non-Profit Societies
 - Registered Charities
 - Service Organizations
 - Local Sport Organization or Team
- 1.4. *City Services and Assets* – direct costs of services and assets provided by City departments that are essential to the delivery of your proposed activities. City services are the costs related to service delivery including staffing, vehicle costs, etc. City Assets are City-owned physical items such as barriers, garbage containers, bleachers, etc. Use of City services and assets have a cost to the City and the City must account for all costs associated with the Community Grants Program.
- 1.5. *Individuals* – Residents of New Westminster.
- 1.6. *Local Sport Organization or Team* – New Westminster based organizations that deliver amateur sport programs for the community for either recreational or competitive purposes. These organizations may or may not be incorporated as a Society.
- 1.7. *Non-Profit Societies* – Organizations that are incorporated under the Societies Act in British Columbia, provincially or under the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act, federally. They may or may not be a registered charity.
- 1.8. *Proposed Activities* – refers to all activities that the applicant will undertake upon approval of funding; including one-time projects, ongoing programs, events, services, festivals, specialized equipment, or requests for ongoing operating funds.
- 1.9. *Service Organizations* – community organizations that deliver their own programs, donate to other organizations in their community, and/or provide scholarships and bursaries.



- 1.10. *Registered Charity* – organizations that have been approved by the Canada Revenue Agency as a Registered Charity in Canada.
