New Opportunities

Call to Artists – Artist Roster

- Public Art Projects under \$25,000 as opportunities become available
- Projects may include artist residencies, design-only, traffic signal boxes, banners, temporary installations, sculptures and murals
- Eligibility – artists practicing in any media
- Call open September, selected November/December
- Contracted between Jan 2022 - Jan 2024 (2 years), then can repost call or extend

New Opportunities

Expression of Interest – Open Call for Artist-Initiated Projects

- Support artist-led initiatives, experimentation and build capacity for artists who may be new to public art;
- Maximum budget of \$30k;
- Any medium, including interventions, non-object based work and temporary installations;
- Two phase process;
- Call open September, shortlist artists November, contracted by January;
- Up to ten months to complete project.
