TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1: You are eligible to enroll in the PAP plan only once your Electrical Utility account has been paid in full.
- 2: PAP withdrawals will be made per the billing due date, in the amount necessary to pay the full balance.
- 3: Residents must notify the City 10 days prior to the next withdrawal for any changes to the PAP. Forms are available online at <https://www.newwestcity.ca/services/online-forms/articles/4960.php>
- 4: PAP withdrawals may be cancelled with 10 days written notice.
- 5: Credits remain with the account. If the property is sold, credits must be adjusted between the vendor and purchaser. Any withdrawals made prior to the 10 day notification deadline will not be refunded.**
- 6: A service charge will be applied to your account for dishonored payments.
- 7: Two consecutive dishonored payments will result in cancellation of the PAP plan.
- 8: Accounts with arrears balances are subject to 'Transfer to Property Taxes' as outlined in the Community Charter and/or bylaw authorized thereunder.
