The City of New Westminster has an ambitious Master Transportation Plan, and requires a forward-thinking, motivated and dynamic senior transportation planner on a temporary basis to cover a parental leave. In this role, you will help achieve the City's transportation goals, with a focus on making it safer, more comfortable and more convenient for people of all ages and abilities to walk, ride a bike and take transit in New Westminster. Your duties will focus on delivering a limited number of priority initiatives, including the urban design and policy framework for 2 great street corridors, and; updates to the Street and Traffic and Zoning bylaws as they relate to sustainable transportation, travel demand management, parking cash-in-lieu, new mobility, access control and goods movement.

### REQUIREMENTS

- University degree in planning, geography, urban studies or a related field plus sound related professional experience preferably in a municipal transportation setting. An equivalent combination of training and experience as acceptable to the employer may be considered.
- Advanced knowledge of the principles, practices, techniques, methods and procedures applicable to municipal planning.
- Sound knowledge of the City of New Westminster's 2014 Master Transportation Plan, the City's transportation system, and current TransLink and municipal transportation policy, principles, standards and methods.
- Significant knowledge of several fields related to transportation planning, such as law, economics, development practices, municipal finance, and of current trends and developments in these areas.
- Considerable knowledge of the policies, rules, regulations, bylaws and legislation governing the work.
- Experience in the timely processing and oversight of complex development projects, at all stages, and preparing related reports.
- Experience participating in community and transportation planning processes and in representing the municipality and department on planning matters.
- Experience participating in various meetings and other engagement related to the work such as Council meetings and engaging various stakeholders in a strategic and constructive way.
- Experience working closely with other senior staff in formulating, implementing, modifying and improving transportation plans, processes and procedures.
- Experience in implementing contemporary customer service excellence in conflict situations.
- Ability to plan, assign and supervise the work of professional and technical staff, and to apply excellent people management and leadership skills.
- Ability to consult, liaise and coordinate with other staff, external public and private agencies, consultants, residents, business and other community interests..
- Demonstrated ability and experience in facilitation, negotiation and conflict resolution.
- Ability to be creative and exercise sound judgment in a fast paced environment while managing multiple tasks and resolving conflicts.
- Ability to express ideas effectively both orally and in a written manner.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees, professionals and the public.
- Sound knowledge of the roles and responsibilities of the external agencies involved in transportation issues affecting the City.
