The main responsibility will be the preparation and serving of fast food and beverages.

Requirements include:

- Ability to learn cash handling skills with the ability to receive payments and make change quickly and accurately.
- Ability to provide friendly and fast service.
- Ability to work alone, without supervision, and to work well with others.
- Ability to make sound decisions and problem solve.
- Ability to safely clean equipment and keep work areas tidy and well stocked.
- Previous related experience would be an asset.
- Ability to learn processes and take direction.

*You must be available to work a variety of shifts including days, evenings, weekends and statutory holidays from July 1 until September 7 (and must be available in the evening and weekends for training in June). Concession workers could be scheduled to work 3 to 5 shifts per week, each shift is between 2 to 5 hours. Please note that shifts are subject to change due to weather, attendance and events. Shifts at an outdoor concession will be cancelled on days of poor weather conditions. Shifts at an indoor concession are subject to changes in length and/or cancellation due to low patron attendance.
