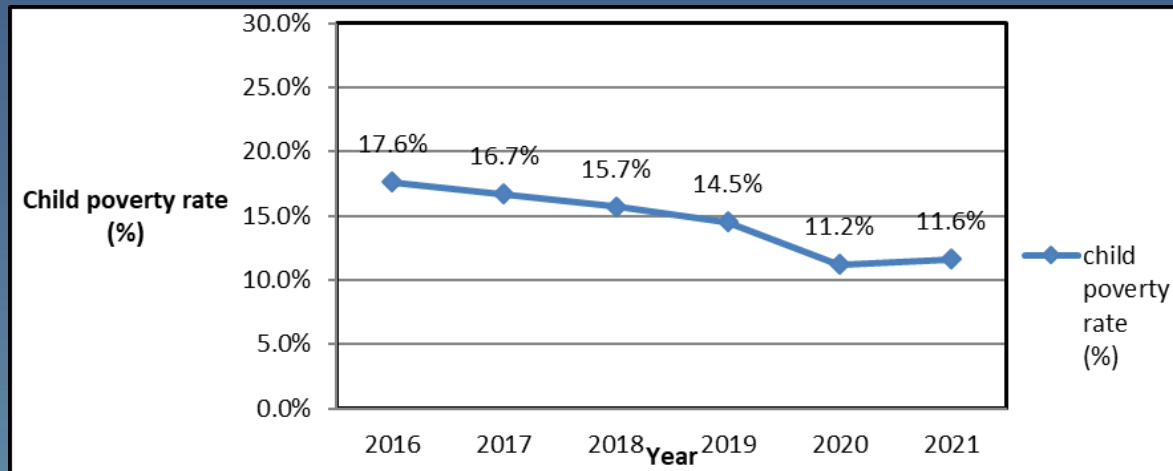
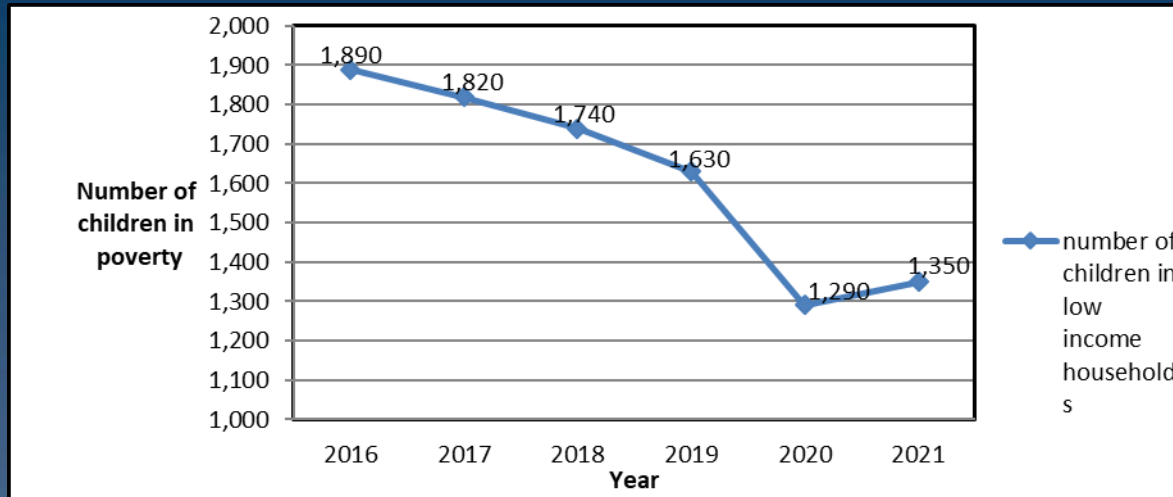

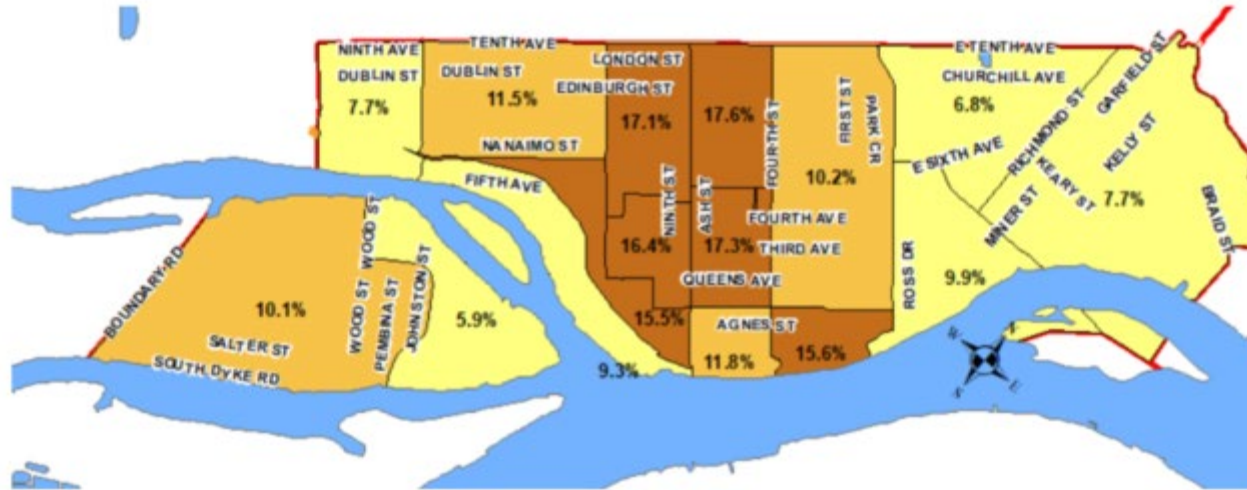

Child poverty went down during the pandemic

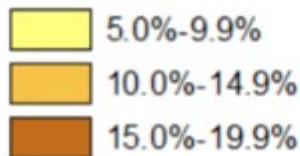


Some neighbourhoods have more poverty

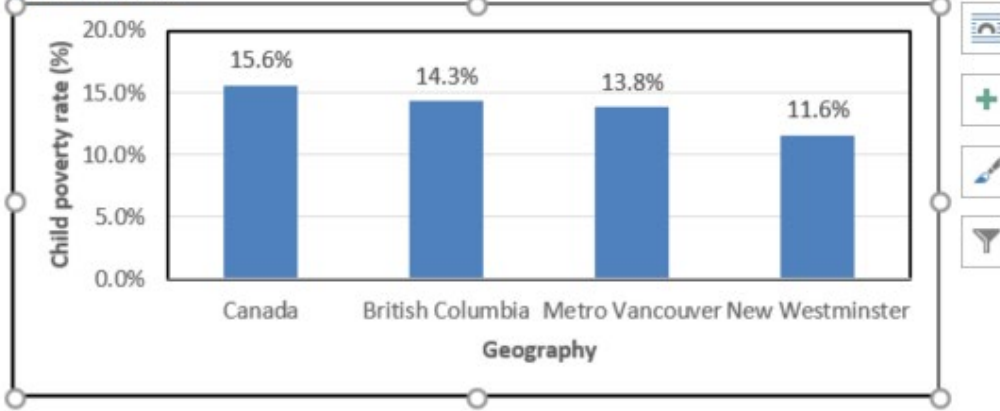
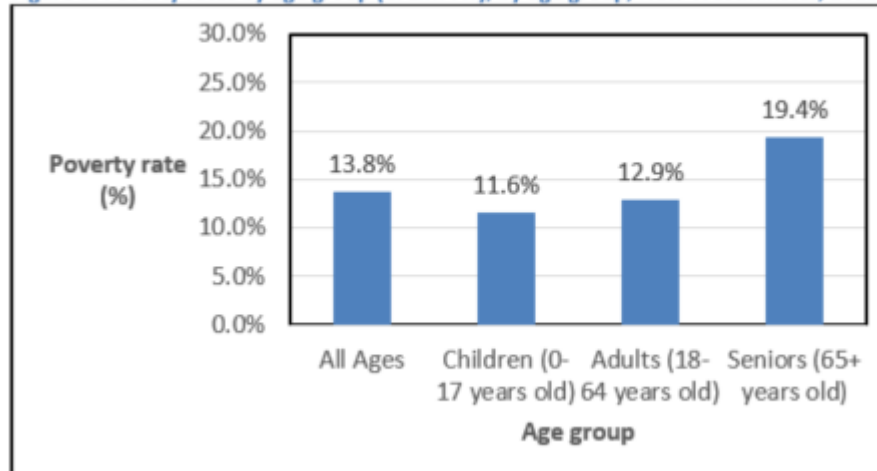
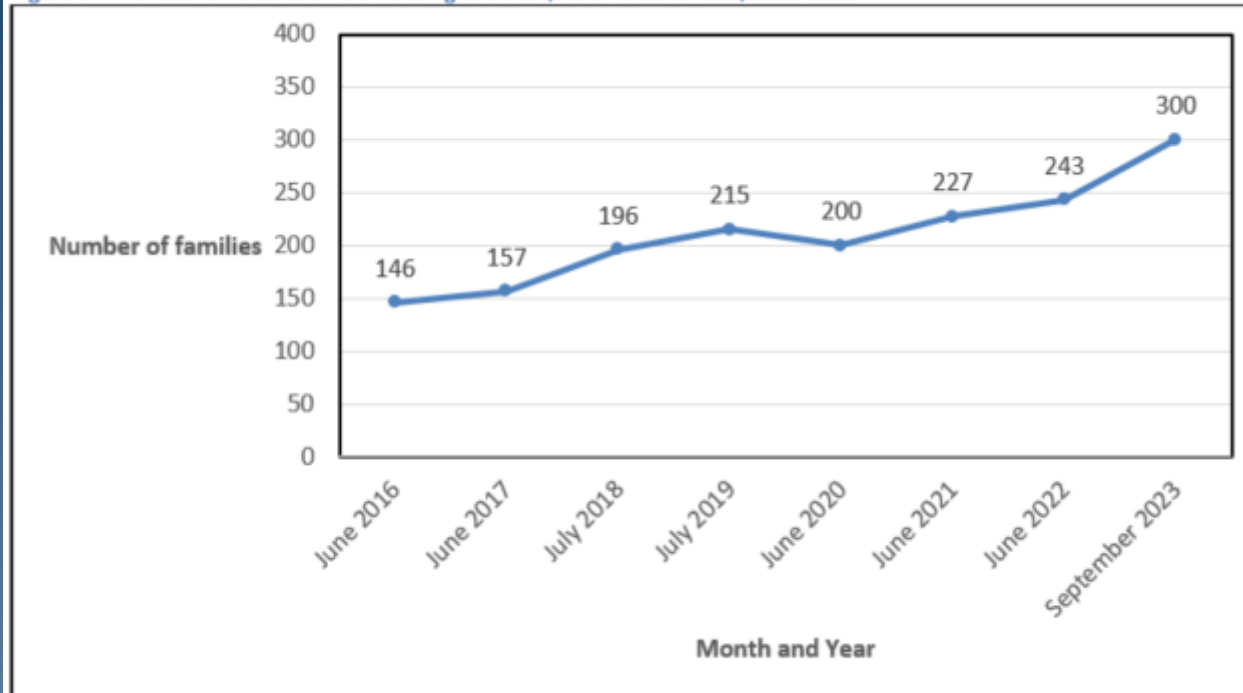


Figure 3: Poverty rates by age group (CFLIM-AT), by age group, New Westminster, 2021 Taxfiler data
