### **2.0 Review of “Speak Up About Heritage!” Event (November 21, 2015)**

The Working Group requested that they be allowed to give a brief presentation to the Land Use Planning Committee on December 7, 2015, as part of the staff report on the agenda that day. Jennifer, Rebecca and Dave V. offered to do the presentation. Julie will send the Working Group a summary of the revised strategies and actions (based on the feedback from the “Speak Up” event) in order for Jennifer, Rebecca and Dave to create their presentation. The other Working Group members were invited to attend the December 7<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Discussion was held on how to ensure that the draft strategies and actions work with each other. For example, the incentive of higher Floor Space Ratio must work with the Heritage Conservation Area. It was decided that another meeting would be necessary to ensure that the strategies and actions are ready for presentation to Council in the new year.

The Working Group would like to recommend a Heritage Conservation Area as the first choice, based on the positive feedback from the “Speak Up” event. There was discussion on the finer points of a Heritage Conservation Area, in particular the differences between

being in a Heritage Conservation Area and being listed on the Schedule. It was suggested that the City Solicitor attend the next meeting of the Working Group for a Question and Answer session. This has been arranged for Thursday January 21, 2016 in Committee Room #2, 6:00pm.
