Replacement Trees shall meet the following criteria:

- Be at least 3cm caliper; 5-6cm is optimal
- Reach a minimum height of 5m (20ft) at maturity
- No weeping, dwarf, hedge, or palm species or varieties
- No fruit-bearing species such as apple, pear, plum, cherry, and peach (unless listed above)
