Once a speeding issue has been validated through data collection and speed humps are deemed by City staff to be a suitable intervention, it is your responsibility to gauge the support of residents and businesses on the affected block. City staff will help you determine which residents and businesses will need to be surveyed. Only one signatory, aged 18 or over, per household or business will be counted.

All households, including those in multi-unit residences (strata or rental), should have the opportunity to provide input, regardless of whether the residents rent or own their home. For businesses, a letter of support from the business owner/manager and/or property management company is required.

At least 50% of identified residents and businesses will need to indicate support for the installation to proceed.
