

INVITATION TO TENDER

Project: 2010 Sanitary Pumping Stations, Quayside & Lower Hume Park

The Corporation of the City of New Westminster invites tenders for the construction of two sanitary pumping stations; one located near 1260 Quayside Drive and one located in Lower Hume Park. At each pumping station site the work includes:

- Installation of a packaged duplex pumping station;
- Underground electrical circuitry installations;
- Modifications to an existing electrical load centre;
- Interception of the service piping from an existing washroom building and connection to the pumping station;
- Installation of overflow and drain piping between the pumping station and existing storage tanks;
- Installation of forcemain piping by conventional open trenching;
- Installation of forcemain piping by trenchless techniques at Quayside;
- Installation of forcemain piping through an existing carrier pipe at Lower Hume Park;
- Installation of a forcemain flush out & inspection chamber;
- Connection to the existing Metro Vancouver interceptor sewer at Quayside;
- Connection to the City sewer at Lower Hume Park;
- Start-up and commissioning;
- Preparation of an operation and maintenance manual.

The successful tenderer will be required to provide a Performance Bond and a Labour and Materials Payment Bond, both in the amount of 50% of the total tendered amount shown on the Form of Tender and drawn up in accordance with the requirements specified in the Contract Documents.

The official time will be that indicated on the clock located at the information desk. Late submissions will be returned unopened.
